The Headlong Theater Company in London has announced that the world premiere of the musical adaptation of "American Psycho," based on the 1991 novel by Bret Easton Ellis, will be part of its 2012-13 season. Rupert Goold ("Enron") will direct the production, which has music and lyrics by Duncan Sheik ("Spring Awakening") and a book by Roberto Aguirre-Sacasa ("Spider-Man: Turn Off the Dark"). An opening date has not been set.
